



WIDENING POOLER PARKWAY!

To help ease traffic now and in the future, Pooler City Council has approved plans to widen Pooler Parkway. Throughout the course of the 18-month project, a third lane will be added in both directions from Benton Boulevard to the Interstate 95 southbound ramps. In addition, motorists can expect new turn lanes, intersection updates at Mill Creek Circle, and a free-flow right turning lane off the I-95 southbound ramp to keep traffic moving and reduce backups. 
