Need help or have a question?

Here's the best way to contact Sentry Management

Have a question about your account, need assistance or want to report a community-related problem or concern? The easiest way to make sure your request reaches the right person — and can be tracked through resolution — is to email communitycare@sentrymgt.com.

When you email the CommunityCare team, your message creates a support ticket in Sentry Management's CommunityCare Center. A representative will review your request, associate it with your account and respond with a reference or ticket number that can be used to track the issue.

To help Sentry route your request correctly, always include your full name, community/association name and property address, along with a clear description of your question, concern or request.

Sentry typically responds within 24–72 hours (one to three business days), although response times may vary depending on the nature of the request and current ticket volume.

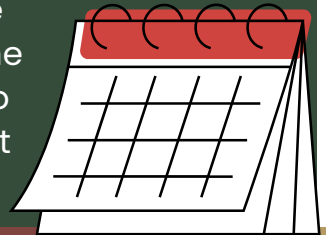
Using the CommunityCare email also creates a record of your request, making it easier for Sentry to track questions and concerns and follow up as needed.
