Dues: A quick run-down

- The Villages at Godley Station's fees are due semi-annually by January 1 and July 1. The 2025 annual dues are \$830. They're split into two payments of \$415 each.
- There is a 30-day grace period. Any dues that have not been paid by January 31 and July 31 are considered delinquent and a 10% FINE (of the assessment) is added; delinquency notifications and invoices will be mailed to homeowners.
- To avoid a fine, residents are encouraged to pay their dues well before the grace period ends. Payments must have cleared the bank by Jan. 31 and July 31. Payments that have been postmarked by those dates or scheduled online are still considered late.
- There are three options for making payments. To make **online payments**, utilize ClickPay, which is the HOA's preferred way of accepting assessment payments. To pay or set up a ClickPay account, click [here](#).
